JOB DESCRIPTION

You will be responsible for acquiring QEEG data from the clients and generate brain maps for therapy and conduct neurofeedback sessions based on those maps.

You will report directly to the clinical director through detailed and written clinical reports; these reports encompass session-to-session written tracking of the client's progress.

You will be in charge of biofeedback/ neurofeedback and microcurrent equipment as well as ensuring that adequate supplies are present.

You are in charge of receiving cash/credit card payments from clients.

You will help scheduling clients whenever possible and through a very organized approach you will Liaise with other interdisciplinary colleagues in order to create an integrative model of brain health.
