**Position Overview:** Lead the QEEG informed neurofeedback clinical service program for the treatment of ADHD/ADD and insomnia at NeuroCare Centers of America new Cool Springs, TN location. Successfully perform neurofeedback treatments to provide lasting clinical benefits for patients suffering from ADHD/ADD using QEEG to inform treatment selection and implementation of evidence based treatment protocols. This position is part time to start so would allow time for the clinician in this role to maintain an existing clinical service for existing/new patients outside the scope of this position. Renting of the same office space used by the person in this role (which is in a professional medical office building), is also available for use when conducting private clinical services outside of this position. Professional on-site neurofeedback, QEEG and Actigraphy training are included with the position.
